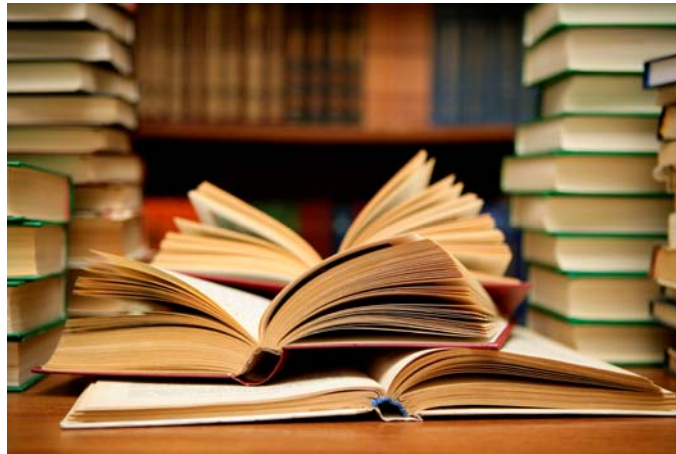

Services Offered: Testing

Testing at DII is conducted in a one-on-one structured environment and consists of a battery of standardized tests recognized by school systems and other professionals in the field.

- Full Educational Evaluation (includes Cognitive and Academic)
- Cognitive IQ Evaluation
- Academic Evaluation
- Kindergarten Readiness Evaluation
- Consultations

Tutoring

Remedial tutoring services for individuals (ages 4-adult) with learning differences in reading, writing, and spelling. One-on-one tutoring options include:

- Reading (Orton-Gillingham approach)
- Fluency and Comprehension
- Multisensory Math
- Expressive Writing

Sessions are held in an area convenient for families and may include our office, schools, libraries, or other community centers. Sessions are available two to three times per week, Monday through Friday, year-round. Financial aid is available for those who qualify.

Camp Delafield

Established in 1990, Camp Delafield is a four-week summer day camp for youth ages 7-12. Camp Delafield offers both a rigorous academic program and a diverse arts and recreational program. *Scholarships are available.*
